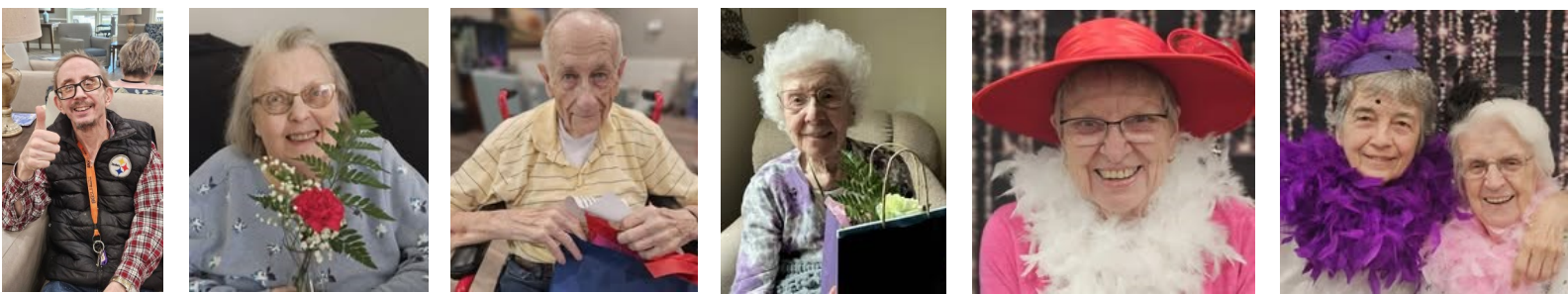

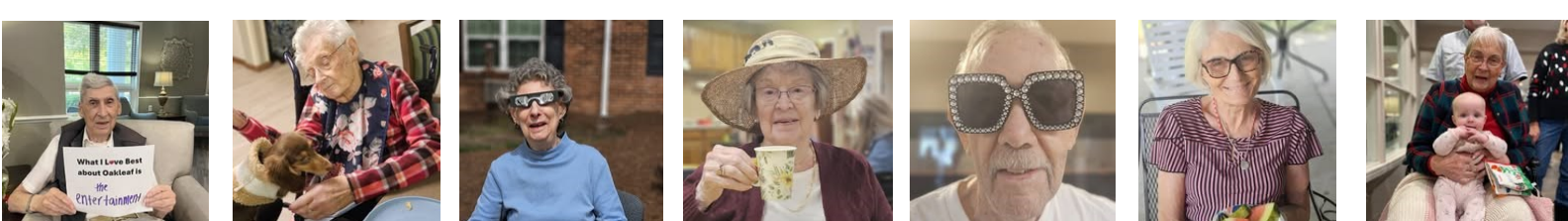
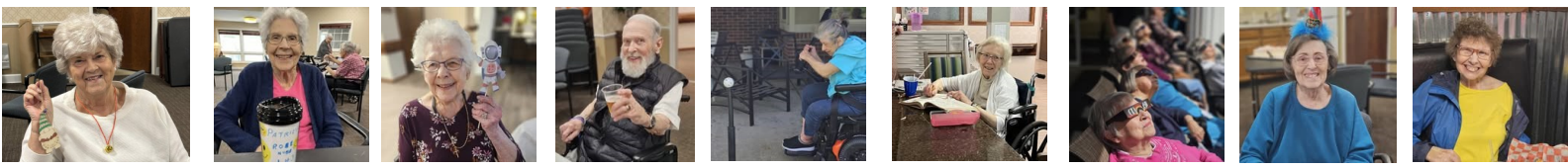

'Out with the old, in with the new!'

Happy New Year & Welcome 2025! Let's welcome the new year by cleaning out our fridge & cupboards, checking the 'best if used by' or expiration dates. Or if you notice a fuzzy-green monster growing on it or foul odor, **TOSS IT!**

Some commonly used items to check expiration dates/quality for:

- Bread
- Milk
- Fresh Fruits & Vegetables
- Yogurt
- Opened packages of food
- Cheese
- Anything that is not 'sealed fresh' or previously opened
- Leftovers 3 days or older

It's a healthy habit to immediately clean up any spills or messes in your kitchen. Keeping a clean kitchen and practicing proper food storage can help prevent bacteria. Keep hot food hot, cold food cold, and raw foods separate, and ALWAYS wash your hands before and after handling food and before eating.

While cleaning, if you notice you took home any of Oakleaf's kitchen dishes (to-go containers, coffee cups, plates/bowls, silverware), please return to the kitchen!
